Entry and Eligibility Rules:

Open to AHA Members of record as of **Saturday, June 13**.

Check <https://associationhawaiiartists.com/members/> to verify you are current.

Participating Artists are **required** to sit the show. Separate info and signup instructions forthcoming.

All 2D and 3D media accepted. All work must be original images by the entering artist. Only the artwork entered will be installed (however, sold pieces can be replaced by similar artwork).

We will not accept entries that require special installation including supplemental information or display items (except settings for 3-D work). AHA reserves the right to refuse entry of any work deemed by the Exhibit/Installation Team to contain any of the following: inappropriate content, insufficient presentation, or any other condition that poses a problem for installation. Decisions by the Installation Team are FINAL.

Wet work or pieces that are NOT WIRED and ready to hang will be rejected immediately. At its highest point, wire should be at least 2.5 inches BELOW the top of the artwork so that the Ho'omaluhia hanging system is not visible.

Plexiglas is PREFERRED. AVOID GLASS, especially on large pieces.

By law, the Artist is responsible for providing a Certificate of Authenticity on any/all multiple(s) in AHA shows.

AHA does not ship artwork. Shipping is the responsibility of the Buyer and the Artist.

If you cannot meet all of these requirements, this show is not for you. NO Exceptions.

Juror of Awards:

Jonathan "J.J." Johnson is an accomplished public art consultant with a career spanning over four decades, primarily with the Hawai'i State Foundation on Culture and the Arts where he served as Executive Director, Director of the Hawai'i State Art Museum and as a Public Art Administrator.

Awards:

Best in Show (\$250), 1st Place (\$150), 2nd Place (\$125), 3rd Place (\$100), three Honorable Mentions (\$75).

Artists will be notified if they have won an award.

Submissions:

The completed entry form (PDF or JPEG) **and** digital images (JPEG, BMP etc) must be emailed to ahaartistcommunication@gmail.com by **June 13th, 5 PM HST**. Put "AHA2026" in the subject line. Prepare your Entry Form & Images clearly -- we will create labels, printed and online catalogs, Social Media posts, etc. from this information.

To promote the show in a catalog, on Social Media and/or a QR sales webpage, AHA REQUIRES digital images:

300 dpi JPEG format, 1200 pixels maximum on the longest side.

IMAGES MUST BE LABELED as follows: *ArtistLastName* - *Title*.jpg.

ONLY properly prepared images will be considered. Incomplete entries will be returned.

Entry Fee:

\$35 for 1 or 2 works, each 18x24" or less -- OR -- for 1 work up to 30x40".

3D pieces must fit within 24x24x24" or be freestanding. No artwork can weigh more than 25 pounds.

Diptychs, Triptychs etc. are counted by the piece.

No payments will be accepted on take-in day. Submit your entry fee in **one of the following methods:**

1. Mail a check payable to the **Association of Hawaii Artists (AHA)** to: AHA2026, PO Box 37605, Honolulu HI 96837. Put "**AHA2026**" in the Check Memo to insure proper credit.

2. Use PayPal to send the payment to **treasureAha@gmail.com**. Enter the Amount and "**AHA2026**" in the *What Is This For* space.

Please review ALL Entry and Eligibility Rules as the entry fee is non-refundable.

Take-in Day:

Wednesday, **July 1** from **9:30 AM - Noon**. Only artists who have pre-registered should bring their work to the take-in location.

No late entries. Place a completed label (last page of this prospectus) on the back (2D) or bottom (3D) of each piece. Also bring an 8 ½ x 11" BIO in a sheet protector for promotional purposes.

Reception:

An Artist Reception and Awards Presentation will take place **Sunday, July 12** from **1 - 3 PM**. AHA will provide light refreshments – there's no need to bring potluck items.

Take-Down Day:

Friday, **July 31** from **9:30 AM - 1 PM**.

REMEMBER TO PICK UP YOUR ARTWORK ON THIS DATE. There are no storage facilities. AHA, Ho'omaluhia Botanical Gardens and C&C Honolulu are NOT responsible for ANY unclaimed artwork.

Liability:

AHA will handle your work with the best of care. However, neither AHA nor the Ho'omaluhia Botanical Garden nor City and County of Honolulu assume any responsibility for theft, loss, or damage of any kind. Liability insurance is the Artist's responsibility.

Commission:

AHA asks a 15% commission on pieces sold from this show. ALL SALES WILL GO THROUGH A QR CODE TO THE AHA WEBSITE FOR PROCESSING. NO DIRECT SALES ARE ALLOWED ON C&C PREMISES. Artists are paid within 30 days of the close of the show.
